1.	The target group	9 – 18 years old
2.	The goal of the workshop	Encourage participants to use new materials used in making artworks – Sculpture with stones.
3.	Tasks of the workshop:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> To acquaint the participants to work with natural materials and tools, such as stones. To give them the opportunity to try new, unknown technique of making art.
4.	Expected results	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Participants of the workshop have got the main idea and the basic principles of this technique. Participants of the workshop have tried to make sculpture of stones.
3.	The plan of the workshop (60 min)	<p><u>10 min.</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Talks. Introducing of theme of the workshop (the new, unknown technique - sculpture). - Exploring the prepared materials - a variety of small stones, brushes, plastic colour or tempera, silicone and Styrofoam. - Exploring the basic principles of the stone sculpture <p><u>5 min.</u></p> <p>Choice of the subject and actuality of the theme displaying in the visual work of art (the influence of local artists work, traditional art, impressions of season and other).</p> <p><u>35 min.</u></p> <p>Practical work – making the artwork “Sculpture with red stone strawberries”.</p> <p><u>10 min.</u></p> <p>Job analysis, summary conclusions (ideas for the next workshop, small exhibition and other).</p>
